Middle-Level Board Meetings

The Middle-Level Board of Control met virtually this year for general discussions of topics of interest and concern to members, including school climate and culture and the legal language around bullying and restorative practices. The Board was instrumental in providing ideas, input, and feedback to the Center for Leadership and Innovation.

NAESP and NASSP National Leadership Conference and Virtual Capitol Hill Day This year, the NAESP and NASSP National Leadership Conference took place in person in Washington, DC, and an advocacy team of principals from Connecticut attended meetings with Congressional leaders and their staffers.
