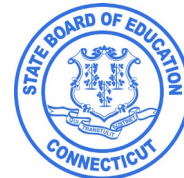

Dear Superintendents and High School Principals:

Since July 1998, two Grade 12 public school students have been seated on the Connecticut State Board of Education ("Board"). The students, who are appointed by the Governor, serve a one-year term, beginning July 1 of each year.

We are now beginning the search process for the 2025–26 student Board members. The application package is attached and can be downloaded by accessing the Connecticut State Department of Education's website at <https://portal.ct.gov/sde>. Please inform your students of the 2025–26 application process by posting the *Notice to Grade 11 Students* on a centrally located bulletin board, on your website, and any other means of communicating with students, including morning announcements. *Please distribute this notice to your school counselors, PTA presidents, and student council members.*

Completed application packages must be received by mail **or** email (in .pdf format) by March 17, 2025. The **submitted .pdf order** is (1) signed application form; (2) three reference letters from your teachers or school administrators; (3) your resume; and (4) a one-page statement describing why you would like to serve on the Board and your opinion on the education issue that you consider to be most critical.

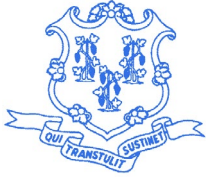
Applications received after March 17 will **not** be accepted. The State Student Advisory Council on Education (SSACE) will review all applications in April 2025 and will select students for an interview. An SSACE panel will conduct interviews in May 2025, and will refer five of those individuals to the Governor for his consideration. The Governor will appoint two students to serve on the Board from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

Please encourage qualified students in your school to submit their applications. I look forward to your school's participation in this unique opportunity for students.

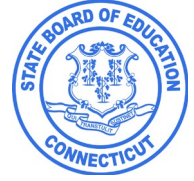

NOTICE TO GRADE 11 STUDENTS

Student Member of the Connecticut State Board of Education, 2025–26

Application Process



Every year, the Governor appoints two public school students entering their senior year to serve on the Connecticut State Board of Education for a one-year period (July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026). Although they do not have voting privileges, student Board members participate fully in discussions about education policy and lend an important perspective to Board deliberations. We encourage you to consider applying for membership on the Board.

Are You Qualified?

Students who wish to apply for membership on the Board:

- must be enrolled in a public high school; and
- must have at least a B+ average; and
- will have completed Grade 11 prior to July 1, 2025; and
- must be able to attend monthly all-day meetings in Hartford (usually the first Wednesday of each month).

Screening Process

The State Student Advisory Council on Education (SSACE) will review all application packages. Based on its review, the Council will select applicants for interviews to be conducted in May 2025. At the conclusion of the interview phase, the Council will recommend five candidates to the governor for his consideration. The governor will appoint two students to the Board for a one-year term commencing July 1, 2025.

Notice of State Student Advisory Council on Education:

Application packages for 2025–2026 will be electronically submitted to members of SSACE for their virtual and in-person review.

- a one-page statement describing why you would like to serve on the Board and your opinion on the education issue that you consider to be most critical.

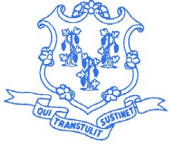
